# Colorado Division of Motor Vehicle Implements Print on Demand License Plates

Improving Customer Service and County Business Practices

**April 21, 2014 – Denver, CO.** Print on Demand eliminates the need for customers to visit the motor vehicle office multiple times, for certain types of license plates. It also provides Colorado Counties with an efficient and effective way to manage low issuance license plate inventory, while making plates readily available to the customer.

The Division of Motor Vehicles in conjunction with Colorado County Clerks, Governor's Office of Information Technology and Colorado Correctional Industries worked together to create the Print On Demand program. This program creates a process where lower issuance plates are mailed to the customer, and eliminates the need for multiple visits to the motor vehicle office.

In an effort to make plates readily available and ease inventory levels at counties throughout Colorado, the Division of Motor Vehicles worked closely with Colorado County Clerks to create the Print On Demand where applicants for low issuance plates can obtain the plate with one visit to a Motor Vehicle Office. This plate is then mailed to the applicant within five business days. A full-list of plates that are included in this Print On Demand program are available online at <a href="https://www.colorado.gov/revenue">www.colorado.gov/revenue</a>.

In testing this program, the Division of Motor Vehicles worked with three test counties to ensure the program deployed efficiently. In working with these counties, the testing went smoothly and plates were successfully registered to applicant's vehicles.

Print On Demand will be rolled out to all counties in a phased format. The first counties to be transitioned to Print on Demand will be the week of April 21-25, to view a complete list of the counties by rollout date, please visit <a href="www.colorado.gov/revenue">www.colorado.gov/revenue</a>.


### Vehicle Registrant,

You are receiving this letter with enclosed license plate and registration receipt because you elected to register your vehicle with a license plate that is completed through the <u>Print on Demand</u> process when you registered your vehicle with your County Motor Vehicle office.

Please follow the steps below to <u>activate</u> this license plate and your vehicle registration. Please have the registration receipt enclosed with this letter available during the activation process. Your vehicle registration is not completed until the <u>Activation</u> of this license plate and vehicle registration is completed. Failure to complete the activation will result in your vehicle not being properly registered.

### **Activation Steps**

- 1. Locate the registration receipt in the envelope.
- 2. Locate your license plate and vehicle information on the registration receipt (sample below). This information is required to activate the license plate and vehicle registration.



- 3. Log onto www.coprintondemand.com or call 1-800-685-7891.
- 4. Enter your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN), License Plate Number and this Activation Code (XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX).
- 5. Complete the steps under **Once Activation is Completed** below.

### **Once Activation is Completed**

- 1. Remove the temporary registration permit and destroy it along with the registration receipt provided with it.
- 2. Affix the license plate to your vehicle. Please ensure the license plate with the year and month tabs is placed on the rear of the vehicle in the license plate mounting area.
- 3. Retain the registration receipt provided with this license plate for proof of vehicle registration.

4. Once activated, your County Motor Vehicle office will update your vehicle registration records. All future transactions on this license plate and vehicle will be completed with your County Motor Vehicle office (i.e., renewal, change of address etc.).

Failure to complete the activation process prior to placing them on your vehicle will result in your vehicle registration being invalid. This may result in law enforcement actions for invalid vehicle registrations, fines, fees or other administrative/punitive actions.
